# Size Matters. 



Standard beer, cider or cooler:

12 oz
(341ml)


Standard spirits: 1.5 oz
(43ml)


Standard glass of wine: 5 oz
(142ml)

## Not all drinks are created equal. One standard drink equals:

- $341 \mathrm{ml}(12 \mathrm{oz})$ bottle of $5 \%$ alcohol beer, cider or cooler
- 43 ml ( 1.5 oz ) shot of $\mathbf{4 0 \%}$ spirits (vodka, rum, whisky, gin etc.)
- $142 \mathrm{ml}(5 \mathrm{oz})$ glass of $\mathbf{1 2 \%}$ wine

Prefer to drink higher alcohol beer, coolers, ciders and wines? If so, take note that even though the serving size in your glass appears the same, your drink actually contains more alcohol per volume and is therefore equal to more than one standard drink.

If you drink or host, know what a standard drink is.
