1.	Pre-Authorized Debit (PAD )	SLGA to initiate payment within 14 days of invoicing, unless otherwise requested  • The pre-authorized debit (PAD) form is the common method of payment for production levies.  • The authorization must be completed (with a Void Cheque or Banking info) and returned to SLGA at the time of the set up.  • Will receive a remittance by e-mail, if registered for eBill, or mail after the payment is processed
2.	Online Banking Payment	Payment initiated by producer within 7 days of invoicing, unless otherwise requested  To make payment for your SLGA invoice, you can use your online banking, bill payment option.  Use permit number as your account number
3.	Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)	<ul> <li>Payment initiated by producer within 7 days of invoicing, unless otherwise requested</li> <li>To make payment for your SLGA invoice, you can process an EFT by requesting it through your bank</li> <li>The Primary email address will be the recipient of email notification of invoices issued on account.</li> <li>The recipient of the email notification that payment has been taken from their bank account.</li> </ul>
4.	E-Transfer	Payment initiated by producer within 7 days of invoicing, unless otherwise requested  To make payment for your SLGA invoice, you can use your online banking, e-transfer option.  Customer needs to include permit number in the message, so SLGA knows to apply payment to the correct account.  Send the transfer to accountsreceivable@slga.com
5.	Credit Card	SLGA initiates the payment (Visa, Mastercard, AMEX)  • Producers who wish to use credit cards for Levy payment must supply credit card authorization to SLGA.  • Credit Cards are charged the day after invoicing
