

COMMERCIAL PERMITTEE BULLETIN #01

Commercial Permittee Bulletins are issued on an as needed basis. The information is primarily intended for Saskatchewan commercial permittee.

Home Delivery Permit

The home delivery policy has been amended to make companies using independent contractors for delivery eligible for a home delivery permit.

Important Details to note:

- All delivery persons are to have valid Serve It Right Saskatchewan (SIRS) certification. For more information on SIRS, see www.sirs.ca.
- Beverage alcohol may only be delivered by persons 19 years of age and older.
- Passengers are not to be transported when beverage alcohol for delivery is in the vehicle.
- The home delivery permittee is responsible for the actions of its contractors, including any noncompliance with *The Alcohol and Gaming Regulation Act, 1997, The Alcohol Control Regulations, 2016,* and the terms and conditions of the permit.
- The home delivery permittee is to maintain an up-to-date list of all its contractors and proof of their completion of SIRS certification, and provide same to SLGA if requested.
- To obtain a home delivery permit, applicants are required to go through SLGA's application and approval process.
- If a retail store permittee, craft alcohol producer, or permitted establishment contracts with an individual or company (e.g. taxi or food delivery company) to deliver beverage alcohol on its behalf, it is to obtain proof that the individual or company has a valid home delivery permit.
